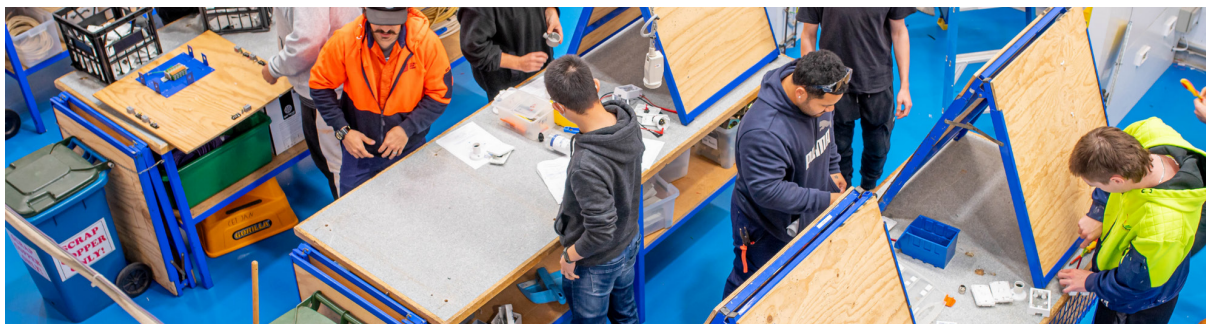




CET POST TRADE COURSE



52899WA Course in Electrical Trade Licensing GAP Training



OVERVIEW

This nationally accredited course is approved by Building and Energy WA and is designed for overseas qualified electricians now residing in Western Australia wanting to gain their WA Unrestricted Electrical License.

REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for enrolment, applicants must hold a provisional license issued by the regulatory authority responsible for regulating electrical work and licensing of workers in the jurisdiction where the training is taking place.

CONTENT

Units of competency:

ETLDIW302	Design and install low voltage electrical wiring
ETLITW301	Inspect and test electrical wiring equipment
UEERE0001	Apply environmentally and sustainable procedures in the energy sector
HLTAID009	Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
UETDRRF004	Perform rescue from a live LV panel

UEEDV0005	Install and maintain cabling for multiple access to telecommunication services
UEEDV0008	Install and maintain cabling for multiple access to telecommunication services
UEEEL0039	Design, Install and verify compliance and functionality of general electrical installations

DURATION

This course will run over 25 days in 3 separate blocks:

10 days	ETLDIW302, ETLITW301, UEERE001, HLTAID009, UETDRRF004
10 days	UEEDV0005, UEEDV0008
5 days	UEEEL0039

Candidates have a maximum period of 12 months in which to complete the 'on-the-job' training.
