UEE20120 – Certificate II in Split Air Conditioning and Heat Pump Systems



OVERVIEW

This course is facilitated and certified by Skillbuild Training through an established partnership with CET.

Designed for licensed electricians and 4th year apprentices who wish to obtain a Refridgerant Handling Licence (RSS03) from the Australia Refrigeration Council (ARC). You will learn to install and decomission single head split systems of less than 18 KWr (cooling capacity).

Theory is taught through face-to-face sessions, aided by learner guides and presentations, covering necessary paperwork and legislation aligned with ARC requirements. Practical sessions take place in a workshop setting with supplied materials. Assessments will include written tasks and practical demonstrations on two inverter air conditioners.

REQUIREMENTS

Learners must hold a current WA Unrestricted Electrician's or Training Licence or equivalent issued in an Australian State or Territory or be in the final year of their electrical apprenticeship. All participants will need a Trainee Licence from the Australian Refrigeration Council to attend the course. Details will be provided so you can apply for this prior to your course.

Learners are required to complete a 2 hour precourse assignment.
